- Cardiovascular Disease is America's Most Costly Killer
- Approximately 810,000 Deaths A Year
- 1 in 3 Adults in the U.S. Suffer From Cardiovascular Disease. That's 92 Million!
- Cardiovascular Disease Kills ~2,200 People In The U.S. Every Day. A Death Every 40 Seconds.
- By 2035 A Projected 45% Of The U.S. Population Will Have Cardiovascular Disease
- \$1.1 Trillion Annual Projected Cost Of Cardiovascular Disease By 2035
- \$555 Billion is the Annual Cost of Cardiovascular Disease Including Medical Expenses & Lost Productivity
- Disproportionally Low NIH Funding. Heart Disease was responsible for 23% of U.S. Deaths in 2014, but received just 4% of NIH Funding. Stroke was responsible for 5% of U.S. Deaths in 2014, but received just 1% of NIH Funding.
