GWTG-Coronary Artery Disease (CAD) was the flagship GWTG module for AMI quality improvement from 2005-2010. In April 2017, The AHA was pleased to announce the re-launch of GWTG-CAD which is fully supporting the Mission: Lifeline program and cardiovascular quality improvement activities. Similar to the AHA's other Get With The Guidelines programs, GWTG-CAD is supported by IQVIA, formerly QuintilesIMS, and was built with familiar interactive features and streamlined functionality. Together, the AHA and IQVIA, offer unmatched customer service along with quality improvement and systems of care implementation expertise.

GWTG-CAD Supports Mission: Lifeline Program:

Since 2010, the AHA's Mission: Lifeline program has recognized hospitals for their outstanding performance in high quality systems of care performance by meeting or exceeding guideline therapy recommendations in treating patients presenting with STEMI heart attacks. GWTG-CAD data is the only data source that will be analyzed for Mission: Lifeline STEMI and NSTEMI Recognition.
