

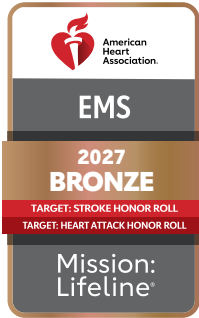

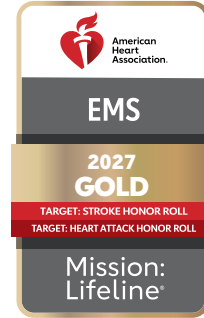

At least one calendar quarter of compliance $\geq 75\%$ for all required measures



Aggregated annual compliance of $\geq 75\%$ for each required measure



Aggregated annual compliance of $\geq 75\%$ for each required measure and Silver or Gold award in prior year

Individual Agency Mission: Lifeline® EMS Award Measures

- AHAEMS1.1** Pre-arrival notification for suspected stroke
- AHAEMS2.1** Documentation of last known well for patients with suspected stroke
- AHAEMS3.1** Evaluation of blood glucose for patients with suspected stroke
- AHAEMS4.1** Stroke screen performed and documented
- AHAEMS5.1** 12-lead ECG performed within 10 minutes for suspected heart attack
- AHAEMS6.1** Aspirin administration for suspected heart attack
- AHAEMS7.1** Pre-arrival notification ≤ 10 minutes for STEMI positive ECG

Volume Criteria: At least 4 patients for the calendar year (>1 STEMI patient and >1 Stroke Patient)

System of Care Distinctions

Target: Cardiac Arrest

Aggregated annual compliance $>50\%$ for all required measures



AHAEMS16.0
OHCA with PSAP call to first compression (bystander or EMS) within 420 seconds

Target: Heart Attack

Aggregated annual compliance of $\geq 75\%$ for all required measures



AHAEMS8.1
EMS First Medical Contact (FMC) to PCI ≤ 90 minutes for Patients with STEMI

or

AHAEMS9.1
EMS First Medical Contact to Thrombolytic Administration <60 minutes for Patients with STEMI

Target: Stroke

Aggregated annual compliance of $\geq 50\%$ for all required measures



AHAEMS12.0
EMS FMC to CT within 60 Minutes for Patients with Stroke

Composite Measure
AHA10.1
EMS first medical contact to thrombolytics within 90 minutes

and

AHAEMS11.1
EMS FMC to Endovascular Therapy within 120 Minutes for Patients with Stroke (AHA STR 189)

Volume Criteria: At least 4 cardiac arrest, STEMI and/or stroke patients for the calendar year based on distinction.



Medical Oversight and State Office of EMS Awards

For Medical Oversight Organizations and State Offices of EMS that provide medical direction, protocols, training, quality reporting, etc. to multiple individually licensed EMS agencies.

- Recognition Requirement same as Individual Agency
- Eligible for System of Care Distinctions
- Recognition is only for the Medical Oversight organization or State Office of EMS
- Individual agencies must submit data to be recognized
- Aggregate denominator/numerator for all licensed agencies in Medical Oversight organization or State Office of EMS
