What does it mean to be a Certified Professional by the American Heart Association (CPAHA) – Tobacco Treatment?

This certification program offers individual professionals a self-directed opportunity to validate their knowledge and experience in foundational telehealth principles and care delivery. Certification is valid for three years.

Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ A minimum associate degree level of education.
- ✓ Complete an accredited Tobacco Treatment education program.
- ✓ Pay any required fee(s)

How Health Care Professionals Benefit

- A self-directed opportunity to validate knowledge and experience in tobacco treatment principles and care delivery.
- A way to show their commitment to helping their patients live longer, healthier lives by stopping the use of tobacco.
- Improve patient care aimed at tobacco treatment delivery and patient outcomes.
- An opportunity to be a part of AHA's gold standard in tobacco treatment and a chance to stand out from competitors.

How To Get Started

- 1** Complete the prerequisite requirements and purchase the certification exam.* You will receive an email from Meazure Learning to schedule your live remotely proctored exam. You will have three hours to complete the 175- questions (150 scored questions, 25 unscored questions).
- 2** Pass the exam. Upon achieving a passing score, the American Heart Association will award you with the CPAHA certification and credentials for individual recognition in accordance with the provided branding guidelines.
- 3** Maintain. To retain the certification past the three-year award period, you must meet certification maintenance criteria with continuing education credits and fees. If the certification is not maintained, it is no longer active for professional use and display.

*Candidates have up to a year to complete the certification exam. Access to the CPAHA Candidate Handbook is included. The Candidate Handbook contains information on content outlines, maintenance requirements, sample questions and more.
